#### Jerez & its bulerías

Jerez de la Frontera became famous throughout the world for its sweet wines named after the town, which the British pronounced "sherry". It is called "de la Frontera" because it once stood on the border between the Moorish and the Christian realms. Jerez is also world famous for its fine horses and brilliant flamenco.

Jerez is located in southern Spain, called Andalucía. It's one of a handful of cities from Cadiz to Granada to Seville that comprise the cradle of flamenco. Artists in each of these cities developed their own style of each palo, much like people develop different dialects of a common language.

Bulerías de Jerez differs from other forms of bulerías because of its distinct palmas, lyrical phrasing and interaction between dancers and the music. It all builds on a rhythm that counts to six, creating a playground with lots of possibilities.
